Ga. House District 35 Candidate Lisa Campbell Endorsed by NARAL Pro-Choice America

ATLANTA, (August 31, 2022) — Today, Ga. House District 35 candidate Lisa Campbell was endorsed by the National Abortion Rights Action League/NARAL for her commitment to restoring a woman's right to reproductive freedom.

"As a woman and lifelong advocate of women's rights, reproductive rights are of utmost concern to me. The overturning of Roe v. Wade, which has allowed Georgia's "Heartbeat Law" to be enacted, is a huge step backward for the women of Georgia, as well as the physicians who are entrusted with their care. I am honored to receive this endorsement from the National Abortion Rights Action League." said Campbell. "I look forward to supporting Georgia women and parents by working to restore reproductive freedom, expanding access to affordable contraception, protecting women who are pregnant from workplace discrimination, and supporting working parents with paid family leave. I trust Georgia women to make decisions in the best interest of both themselves and their families. I vow to stand with the women of House District 35 to restore reproductive rights that were legal for our mothers and grandmothers yet stripped from us in 2022."

Being a woman who is a lifelong advocate of not only women's rights but equal rights for all, Campbell cites reproductive freedom as a top priority. She pledges to advocate for the rights of women to make their own decisions regarding the most personal aspects of their healthcare and lives, in consultation with their own physicians, and without the interference of government.



"Georgia women are trustworthy to make their own healthcare decisions, regarding family planning and are worthy of protecting by creating laws to shield them from workplace discrimination. Georgia parents are hardworking and deserve someone advocating for them under the gold dome by promoting real family values such as paid family leave, access to affordable, quality healthcare, close to home, and the freedom to make private decisions about their own lives including access to safe, legal abortion," stated Campbell.
