## Lisa Campbell wins race for Georgia State House District 35

## Campbell becomes the first woman elected to represent District 35 in the Georgia State House of Representatives

ATLANTA, (November 11, 2022) —Georgia. Cobb County business owner and community leader Lisa Campbell will represent District 35 in the Georgia State House of Representatives after receiving more than 55% of the vote in her race against GOP Candidate, Robert Trim.
